

Title VI Complaint Form

Purpose: It is unlawful for airport operators and their lessees, tenants, concessionaires and contractors to discriminate against, exclude, or deny benefits to any person because of race, color, national origin, sex, age or creed, under any program or activity, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related laws. Use this form to file a discrimination complaint if you believe the Wayne County Airport Authority (“Airport Authority”) has not provided adequate access to services, programs or activities.
