## **Airport Police Chief Elected to SE Michigan Police Chiefs Panel**

**DETROIT** (**December 22, 2014**)---Wayne County Airport Authority Police Chief Edward Glomb has been unanimously elected 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President 2015 of Southeastern Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police. Chief Glomb has served on the organization's Executive Board since 2004.
