Detroit Metropolitan Airport Honored for Procurement and Construction Excellence

Detroit, Mich. (March 26, 2014)—Four awards captured by the management team at Detroit Metropolitan Airport (DTW) and Willow Run Airport (YIP) were presented to the Wayne County Airport Authority (WCAA) Board at its meeting Thursday.

The Airport Authority's Procurement Department was honored as *2013 Entity of the Year* by Michigan Public Purchasing Officers Association (MPPOA). The award recognizes an entity for work or innovations in public purchasing, involvement with the community and contributions to MPPOA and the purchasing profession. (See attached **photo.**)

Michigan Concrete Association's Director of Engineering for SE Michigan, Kerry Sutton, P.E. presented two *Awards of Excellence* to the Airport Authority. One was for the reconstruction and relocation of two DTW service roads and the second for the reconstruction of the northern portion of Runway 4R-22L also at DTW.

Finally, a *Merit Award for Engineering* from the American Council of Engineering Companies acknowledged the complex engineering work that went into DTW's Force Main project. The project allows WCAA to discharge waste water to two separate sewerage treatment plants. This project had previously won an *Environmental Achievement Award* from Airports Council International-North America.

"Our goal has never been to capture awards for their own sake," said WCAA CEO Thomas Naughton. "Our mission is to operate safe and efficient airports. Awards aside, this team of Airport Authority employees makes me proud every day."
